

Call for Papers: Global Radiology Nursing

The Journal of Radiology Nursing is planning a special issue in 2023 on radiology nursing around the world. Sample topics include:

- Global health issues
- Global collaborative initiatives, including interdisciplinary efforts
- Universal nursing concerns and ethics
- Culture and healthcare
- Disparities and inequities (may include health promotion and disease prevention)
- Recognition of radiology nursing in your country
- What's new in radiology nursing in your country
- Education and specialty training for radiology in your country
- Professional nursing organizations in your country
- Areas of opportunities for radiology nurses in your country
- Growth of radiology nursing in your country
- Leadership initiatives
- Tell us about your specialty unit/staff in your country
- Radiology nurse leadership in your country
- Infectious diseases update (TB, AIDS, other)

We are seeking original research and review manuscripts (4000 words), case studies (1000-1500 words), humanities features (1000-1500 words), and short communications (1000-1500 words). Authors should submit an abstract, 3-5 keywords, and several highlights. Authors also may include links to websites, video demonstrations, images for which patient consent has been obtained, forms, documents, or figures (some of which may be online only).

Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reuse copyrighted material before submitting to the journal and must include that permission at submission.

All manuscripts undergo double-blind peer review prior to publication.
